**Are you a Spiritual person? Series (3)** First Work of the Holy Spirit, John 16:1-11

Last week we learned that the Spirit dwells with and in every true believer. **How do we recognize the voice of the Spirit?** We think of the Spirit as a "feeling." <u>How do we distinguish the Spirit from other voices/feelings?</u>

Recognize his handwriting. Know what the Holy Spirit looks like and does.

On Pentecost, Peter preached: *This Jesus, whom you crucified, is Savior and Lord. Now when they heard this they were <u>cut to the heart</u>, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brothers, what shall we do?" Peter said to them, "<u>Repent and be baptized</u> every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Acts 2:36-38* 

The first work of the Holy Spirit is conviction. If you are a believer, He revealed your sinful condition and drew you to the cross; you repented & were saved. <u>Baptism symbolizes that</u>.

The evidence of salvation, the evidence of repentance, and the evidence of faith is a <u>changed</u> and <u>changing</u> life. - **Paul Washer.** 

Repentance has a beginning but is ongoing. It's a regular, continual, daily work of the Spirit.

<sup>8</sup> When he comes, he will <u>convict the world</u> concerning sin and righteousness and judgment: <sup>9</sup> concerning sin, because they do not believe in me; <sup>10</sup> concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father, and you will see me no longer, <sup>11</sup> concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged. John 16:8-11

## **Conviction:**

- 1. Concerning Sin (conviction that leads to salvation in Christ)
- 2. Concerning Righteousness (conviction to keep walking in righteousness)
- 3. Concerning Judgment (conviction that the Ruler of the World is defeated)

**Who is the Ruler of this World**? Recognize darkness. Ignorance of the spirit realm; we can't see Satan; we pursue the things of this world.

## Conviction is the work of the Spirit. Repentance is our response.

The **Spirit convicts us:** Through the Word; through prayer; through the counsel of godly believers; and through circumstances of our life. Our response: repentance.

Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! See if there be any sinful way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting! **Psalms 139:23-24** Example: Pastor, it felt like you were speaking directly to me. Did you repent?

Nothing else I can say in this series of teachings can have any impact unless you yield to the first work of the Holy Spirit. Every day.

I want to invite you to the altar of repentance. What is the sin that is before you? Have you become complacent to the convicting work of the Spirit?
